Detergent

With its unique ingredients, Hydrocare Detergent helps preserve the integrity of fabrics in several ways. As part of its design, Hydrocare Detergent contains a buffering system which helps stabilize fabrics by lowering the interfiber friction during the cleaning process, which reduces felting shrinkage. In addition, the buffering system aids in the minimization of dye bleeding through a protective colloid which helps to preserve colors and retain their intensity.

Because Hydrocare Detergent is "highly active", it is very effective in loosening, surrounding and suspending soil until it can be rinsed away. This helps to ensure that whites stay their whitest and colors stay their brightest.

Retexturizing Finish

Virtually all fabrics need a fabric finish after processing in water to help restore them to their "like new" condition. This is because water soluble fabric finishes are removed during the cleaning process and therefore need to be replaced during the last rinse of the cleaning process.

Hydrocare Retexturizing Finish imparts a crisp, firm hand which most fabrics have when they are purchased. This finish makes fabrics easier to handle during the pressing process and, because of its nature, improves the effectiveness and longevity of the pressed fabric.

Hydrocare Retexturizing Finish dissolves completely and uniformly in water, thereby allowing the finish to completely surround and coat each fiber. This coating not only acts as a protectant by helping to repel certain stains and soils, thus making them easier to remove on the next cleaning, but also provides additional protection for fibers from shrinkage which can occur during the drying process.

Fabric Conditioner

Some fabrics processed in water can become less flexible or pliable, and somewhat harsh to the touch. Many times this is not desirable. Hydrocare Fabric Conditioner imparts a soft and supple feel to fabrics and brings them closer to their original look and feel.

Hydrocare Fabric Conditioner is a surface active agent which affixes itself to the surface of the fibers. This allows Hydrocare Fabric Conditioner to act as an anti-static agent. In addition, it improves the resistance of fabrics to rubbing and abrasion during the drying process, thus helping to minimize shrinkage.

Universal Pre-Treatment

Some fabrics contain heavier localized soiling which cannot be effectively removed by the cleaning process alone. Areas around the collars and cuffs of garments are more often exposed to body oils and perspiration. These body oils tend to attract other soils, thereby causing heavier soiling in these areas. Hemlines on slacks and dresses also tend to have heavier soiling.

Hydrocare Universal Pre-Treatment is specifically formulated to pre-treat heavily soiled areas to remove and suspend soils and allow them to be effectively flushed away during the cleaning process.
